G.S.R. 268.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ganga Flood Control Commission, Technical Class-II post Recruitment Rules, 1973, except as respects things done or omitted to be done, before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Head Draughtsman in Ganga Flood Control Commission, under the Ministry of Water Resources, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Water Resources, the Head Draughtsman, Ganga Flood Control Commission (Group 'B' post) Recruitment Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification, and scale of pay.—The number of the posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. Disqualification.—No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment of the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules, with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion :

Departmental Draughtsman Group 'B' in Pay Band-2 of Rs. 9,300-34,800 with grade pay of Rs. 4,200 with five years regular service in the grade.

Note 1.—Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service, or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Note 2.—For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the 1st January, 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission.

Deputations (including Short Term Contract) :

Officers under the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administration or Universities or recognized research Institutions or Public Sector Undertaking or Semi Government or Statutory or Autonomous Organization ; or

- (a) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
- (b) with five years regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 9,300-34,800 with grade pay of Rs. 4,200 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department;
- (c) having diploma in Civil Engineering or Draughtsman with five years practical experience.

Note 1.—The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation basis. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2.—Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 3.—For purposes of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scales of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only or the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement without any upgradation.
